TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

W. VERNON WHITMIRE of
GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto THE INDEPENDENT LIFE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Florida, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Fifty-six Hundred and No/100** ----- Dollars (\$ **5600.00**), with interest from date at the rate of **six**----- per centum (**6** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of The Independent Life and Accident Insurance Company in Jacksonville, Florida, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Fifty-four and 65/100** ----- Dollars (\$ **54.65**), commencing on the **1** day of **August**, 19**59**, and on the **1** day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the southwestern corner of the intersection of Beatrice Street with a 20 foot access drive in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 7 on a plat of the property of Talmer Cordell recorded in Plat Book 00 Page 171, being more particularly shown on a plat of the property of William V. Whitmire dated June 15, 1959, prepared by J. C. Hill and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Beatrice Street with the 20 foot access drive and running thence with the western side of Beatrice Street S. 21-55 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the front corner of Lot 6 which pin is 203.5 feet northwest of the intersection of said street with Welcome Avenue; running thence with the line of Lot 6 S. 67-48 W. 137.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21-50 W. 60 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of 20 foot access drive; thence with the southern side of said drive N. 67-48 E. 137.3 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Talmer Cordell recorded in Deed Book 622, Page 265.

Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
