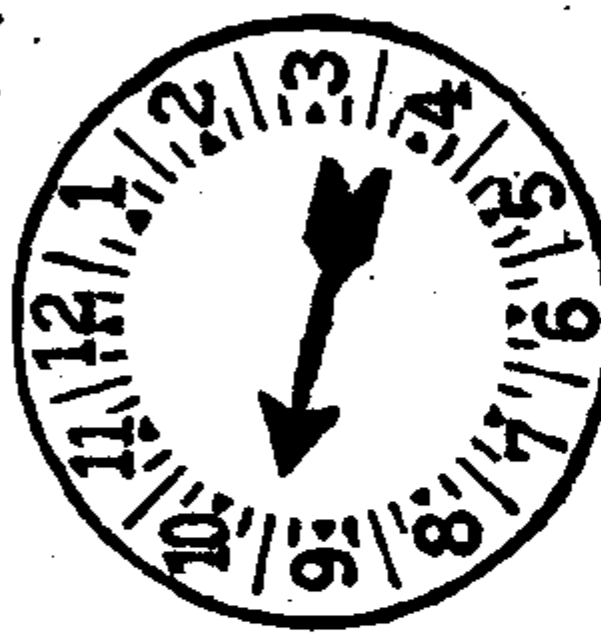

bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per  
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal  
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Margaret Cope Huff,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and  
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Azile C. Cope, my one-half interest in and to all that tract or lot of land in  
Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being known as Tract 3 and a portion of Tract 4 as shown on revised  
plat of property of James H. Cope as shown by plat of property and  
survey of J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, dated March, 1945, revised June  
25, 1951, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County  
in Plat Book O, Page 156, and having according to said revised plat  
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the west side of U. S. Highway No. 25,  
joint front corner of Tracts 2 and 3, and running thence along the  
west side of U. S. Highway No. 25, N. 39-11 W. 250 feet to an iron  
pin, corner of property now or formerly of Hightower; thence S. 63-30  
W. 1070.0 feet to an iron pin on creek; thence S. 13-00 E. with the  
creek as the line, 526.4 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lot 4  
and property now or formerly of Watson; thence along the Watson line  
N. 64-55 E. 774.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-09 E. 333.4 feet  
to a point in line of Tract 3; thence N. 64-55 E. 492.9 feet to an iron  
pin on the west side of U. S. Highway No. 25, the point of beginning.

Subject to a 50-foot easement of the State Highway Department and to  
existing mortgages.
