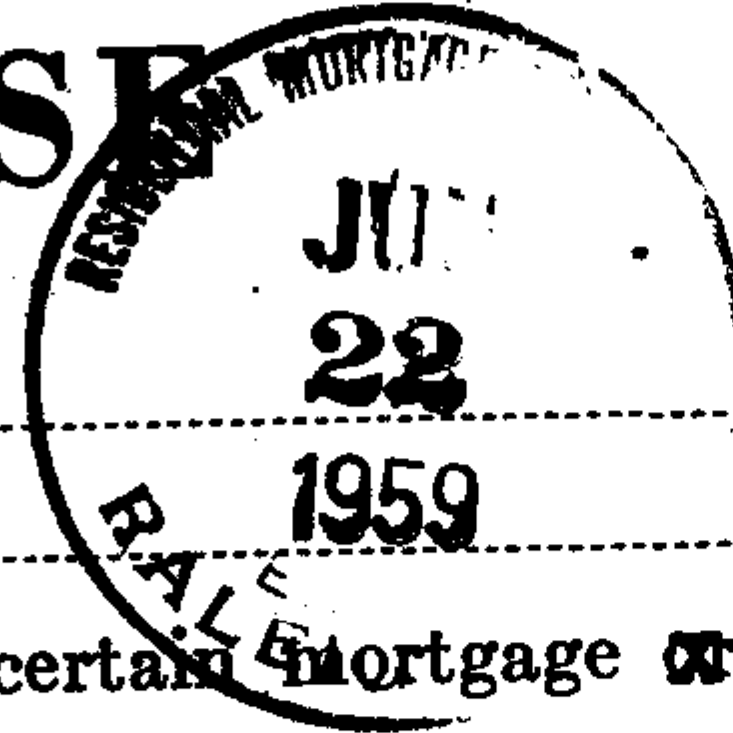


DEED OF PARTIAL RELEASE

Whereas, Marvin B. Crow and Betty T. Crow,

executed a certain mortgage or

THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES, a corporation of the State of New York, dated May 9, 1957, to secure the payment of a note or bond of even date therewith, in the sum of Eighty-five Hundred (\$8500.00) Dollars, recorded in Greenville County, S.C., in Mortgage Book 712 Page 479

Now Therefore, Know All Men By These Presents, that the said THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES, for valuable consideration unto it paid at the execution and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has remised, released and quit-claimed, and by these presents does remise, release and quit-claim unto the Owner or Owners thereof, the following described real property, being in the Greenville County of Greenville and State of S.C., to wit:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the north side of Endless Drive, about two miles northward from the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, and being a small portion of Lot No. 2 of the property of W. Dennis Smith, plat recorded in Plat Book 00, pages 8 and 9, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Endless Drive, corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence along Endless Drive, S. 88-09 W. 23 feet to an iron pin in the front line of Lot No. 2; thence N. 4-00 W. 68.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence along the line of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, S. 21-51 E. approximately 74 feet to the beginning corner.

To have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Owner or Owners, forever freed, exonerated and discharged of and from the aforesaid lien.

Provided always, nevertheless, that nothing herein contained shall in any wise affect, alter or diminish the aforesaid lien or encumbrance on the remaining part of the real property described therein, or the remedies at law for recovering from the parties liable to pay the same the balance of said principal sum, with interest, secured thereby.
