MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, Mary Miller Thomason and Samuel H. Thomason,
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of EIGHTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED & NO/100 - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 18,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five & three-fourths per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northwestern side of Miller Road, and lying just south of the Woodruff Road, in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being shown on the plat of property of Mary Miller Thomason and Samuel H. Thomason, recorded in Plat Book JJ at Page 48, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

"Beginning at an iron pin in Miller Road, at corner of other property of Boyce Miller, and running thence along Miller Road S. 16-20 W. 81.7 feet to pin; thence continuing with said Road S. 29-35 W. 231.5 feet to iron pin; thence with line of property now or formerly owned by Boyce Miller, the following courses and distances: N. 41-17 W. 250 feet to pin; thence N. 31-15 E. 217.6 feet to pin; thence S. 60-47 E. 211.4 feet to the point of beginning, said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagors by Boyce Miller by deed recorded in Volume 556 at Page 27."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
