Office for Greenville County in plat book at page , the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of S. C. Highway 418 (the old section) at the corner of property of Fred E. & Catherine Vaughn formerly owned by Belton Sims and running thence along the property of Fred & Catherine Vaughn N 15-29 W, 1,848 feet to an iron pin on the river; thence with the river as the line, the traverse of which is S 45-10 W, 86.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S 15-29 E, 732.4 feet to an iron pin in the property of V.
