I, Jack B. Thomas (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot 71, Shannon Drive, McSwain Gardens, recorded in Plat Book GG, Page 75, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

"Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Shannon Drive, joint front corner of Lots 70 and 71, and running thence with line of Lot 70, S. 80-30 W. 162.4 feet to iron pin; thence with Brushy Creek, N. 22-04 W. 117 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with said Creek, the chord of which is N. 41-36 E. 101 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with said Branch, N. 17-46 E. 93.2 feet to iron pin on Shannon Drive; thence with said Shannon Drive S. 23-31 E. 268.4 feet to point of beginning; being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Volume 627 at Page 534."
