To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, M. J. Satterfield SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I the said M. J. Satterfield

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to WOODRUFF FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the full and just sum of TWELVE THOUSAND and no/100--- (\$ 12,000.00.) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6 %) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of

One Hundred One and 27/100--- (\$ 101.27) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid. Said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a ten per cent attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible, as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said M. J. Satterfield

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said WOODRUFF FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said

M. J. Satterfield in hand well and truly paid by the said WOODRUFF FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WOODRUFF FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, about 2 miles Northwest of Greer, on the West side of Dogwood Avenue, and being known and designated as lot no. Twenty-three (23) of the W. Dennis Smith property as shown on plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated May 23, 1958 and which plat has been recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book 00, page 118, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an Iron Pin on the West side of Dogwood Avenue at the joint front corner of lots nos. 23 and 24 as shown on said plat, and running thence with the joint property line of said two lots S. 88-38 W. 192.4 feet to an Iron Pin at the joint rear corner of said two lots, thence N. 1-29 W. 129 feet to an Iron Pin, thence N. 88-38 E. 194.7 feet to an Iron Pin on the West side of Dogwood Avenue, thence with the West side of Dogwood Avenue S. 0-27 E. 129 feet to the beginning point. This being the same property which was conveyed to Ray E. Timmerman by W. Dennis Smith by deed recorded in said office in Deed Book 622, page 210. And being the same property which was conveyed to mortgagor herein by Ray E. Timmerman by deed dated this date, which deed will be recorded forthwith in the said office. For a more particular description see the aforesaid plat.
