72nd St. Lateral

A 36-inch lateral pipe line and a 24-inch dual crossing of the Hudson River described as follows:

A 36-inch lateral section approximately 2.61 miles in length, beginning at Mile Post 182746 on the 36-inch Main Line Loop in Bergen County, New Jersey and extending in a southerly direction to a point in Hudson County, New Jersey. A 24-inch dual crossing of the Hudson River approximately 0.804 miles in length (a total of approximately 1.61 miles of pipe) beginning at a point in Hudson County, New Jersey and crossing the Hudson River to a point in New York County, New York. Included in this crossing are the following:

Two 24-inch block valves on the west side of the river, two 24-inch block valves and two 24-inch by 30-inch check valves on the east side of the river.
