GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto
FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION

, a corporation
organized and existing under the laws of UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter

Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South
Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 100
on Plat No. 2 of Sunset Hills recorded in Plat Book P, Page 18, in
the R. M. C. Office and having according to a more recent survey by
R. W. Dalton, dated August 1959, the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Waccamaw Circle
at joint front corner of Lots 99 and 100 and running thence with the
line of Lot 99 N. 48-50 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-10 E.
75 feet to an iron pin on Waccamaw Avenue; thence with said Waccamaw
Avenue S. 48-50 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on Waccamaw Circle; thence
with said Waccamaw Circle N. 41-10 W. 75 feet to point of beginning.
