NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, containing .87 acre, and being more particularly described according to survey of J. C. Hill made in October, 1951, as follows:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap at the edge of the surface treated portion of Miller Road, corner of theMilam property, and running thence S. 65-15 E. 278 feet to an iron pin on boundary between Milam and Gosnell property; thence along Gosnell line S. 39-20 W. 287 feet to a nail and cap at the edge of the surface treatment of Miller Road; thence with said road N. 12 W. 345.6 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Deed Book 284, Page 316.
