All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Dunklin Township and described as follows:

Bounded on the two first lines by church lot and on all other sides by J.E.Knight.
