All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the northern side of Laurens Road in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being composed of a portion of Lot 1. Block A, of a subdivision known as Carolina Court as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 96, and a portion of Lot 14 as shown on a plat of the property of Emma C. Poag recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 68, and being more particularly described in the aggregate as follows:
