SEND GREETING:

, with interest thereon from maturity  
at the rate of 6% per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the N.E. side of Ridge Road about two miles west of Tigerville and bounded by other land of Grantor and containing 0.54 acres, more or less, and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in Ridge Road, a corner of lands of Grantor and Clifford Ford and running thence N67-00E 98 feet to Locust stake; thence S47-30E 155 feet to stake by two Black Gums; thence S47-20W 170 feet to nail and cap in road; thence N23-40W 194.9 feet to BEGINNING."
