That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oaklawn Township, lying on the North side of Wares-Old Hundred Road, and designated as Tract No. 2, of the subdivision of the W. H. King land, as shown by plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, August, 1951, and according to said plat has the following courses and distances to-wit:-
