Furman, Jr., February 3, 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F", page 54, said lot fronting 50 feet on Nelson Street and having a depth of 109 feet on its eastern side and 97 feet on its western side, more or less, said lot being more accurately described by metes and bounds as follows:
