All that lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northern side of Tuscon Drive, being shown and designated as lot # 64 on a plat of Western Hills, recorded in Plat Book QQ at Pages 98 and 99, in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having according to a more recent survey prepared by J. C. Hill November 9, 1959 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
