gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Farmers Bank of Simpsonville, its successors or assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in
Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about
one mile northeast of Mauldin on the western side of Bethel Road
and being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor by J. D.
Green by deed dated May 17, 1947, recorded in Deed Book 313, page
222. It is more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING ON A POINT in the center of Bethel road, joint corner of
the lot conveyed to Jack A. Green, and runs thence with the Jack A.
Green lot line N. 58-35 W. 359 feet to an iron pin on the C. S. Verdin
line and joint corner of the Jack A. Green lot; thence with
the Verdin line N. 30-00 E. 120 feet to an iron pin on the said line;
thence S. 58-35 E. 364 feet to a point in the center of the said
Bethel Road (iron pin back on line at 20 feet); thence with the
center of the said road S. 32-05 W. 120 ft. to the beginning corner,
and containing one (1) acre, more or less.
