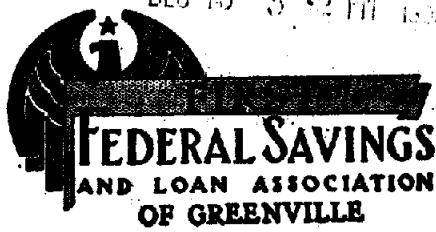

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, W. C. Richey, Jr. and Mary K. Richey of Greenville County

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Ten Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 (\$ 10,500.00) Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

Seventy Five and 24/100 (\$ 75.24) Dollars upon the first day of

each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 26, Section H of Croftstone Acres of a revised plat of a portion of Croftstone Acres prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, August 8, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y at Page 91 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Broughton Drive, joint front corner Lots Nos. 26 and 27 and running thence along the northern side of said Broughton Drive, S. 72-25 W. 70 feet to an iron pin on the joint front corner Lots Nos. 25 and 26; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 17-35 W. 202.4 feet to an iron pin in the right-of-way of the Southern Railroad; thence along the right-of-way line of the Southern Railroad along the rear line of Lot No. 26, N. 72-49 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 26 and 27; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 17-35 E. 201.9 feet to the point of beginning; being the same property conveyed to W. C. Richey, Jr. by J. H. Mauldin by his deed dated May 20, 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 526 at Page 9, the said W. C. Richey, Jr. having conveyed an undivided one-half interest to Mary K. Richey by deed dated December 15, 1959 to be recorded herewith.
