bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per  
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal  
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Mary J. Burry

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and  
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
C. J. McKinney, his heirs and assigns

all that tract or lot of land in  
situate on Parker Road, in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 79, on plat 2 of  
Parker Land Co. property, made by A. S. Bedell, April 1914, recorded  
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book E,  
page 276, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at point in center of Parker Road, corner of lots 84, 80, 74  
and 79, and runs thence S. 77 E. 12.60 chains to red oak corner; North-  
west corner of Tract 74 and in line of Tract 73; thence with line of  
Tract 73 and 78, N. 16-55 E., 12.74 chains to wild cherry; thence with  
line of Tract 83, N. 81 E. 10.45 chains to a point in center of Parker  
Road; thence with center of Parker Road, the following courses and  
distances, S. 16-20 E., 3.80 chains; S. 27-30 E., 2.94 chains; S. 34-40
