Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA at Page 49 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of an unnamed road, sometimes known as Reeves Road at the joint front corner Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 88-21 W. 165 feet to the joint corner Lots nos. 7, 8 and 9 and running thence along the subdivision line, S. 36-30 W. 325.8 feet to a point; thence N. 66-30 E. 243.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-57 E. 150 feet to a point on the western side of said unnamed road, sometimes known as Reeves Road; thence continuing along said Road, N. 0-28 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same property conveyed to us by R. L. Rollins by his deed dated May 18, 1951 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 436 at Page 8.
