Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southeastern side of Nottingham Road, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lot #201 on Plat of Sherwood Forest made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated August, 1951; revised through June, 1953, and recorded in Plat Book GG, pages 70 and 71 (also recorded in Plat Book GG, pages 2 and 3) and having, according to a more recent plat of property of Ralph E. Puckette, prepared by Dalton and Neves, Registered Engineers, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Nottingham Road at joint front corner of Lots #200 and #201, which iron pin is approximately 752.8 feet from the intersection of Legrand Boulevard and Nottingham Road, and running thence with line of Lot #200 S 20-17 E 160 feet to an iron pin; thence S 69-43W 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot #202, N 20-17W 160 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Nottingham Road; thence along Southeastern side of said Road N 69-43E 75 feet to the beginning corner.
