Hammond, in consideration of the said Note and for the better securing the payment thereof to the Said FCX Cooperative Service, Inc., according to the conditions of the said Note, and also in consideration of the further sum One Thousand Three Hundred One and 11/106, to us, the said Thomas D. and Callie B. Hammond, in hand well and truly paid by the said FCX Cooperative Servie, Inc., at before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FCX Cooperative Service, Inc., its successors and assigns, the following personal property:

All of that parcel or lot of land in O'Meal Township of Greenville County, South Carolina lying on the North side of the Mays Bridge Road, about six miles Northwest of the City of Greer, containing one (1) acre, more or less and having the following courses and distances: Begining on an iron pin at the Southwest corner of the C. T. Barnett tract and runs thence S. 58.00 E. 204.2 feet to an iron pin on the North edge of road: thence N. 58 W. 204.2 feet to an iron pin on A. J. Farmer's live: thence S. 47 W. 218.5 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the Northwest by land of A. J. Farmer and on all other sides by lands of the grantor and Roy A. Collins.
