NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being near the Town of Mauldin in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 50 as shown on a plat prepared by R.K. Campbell, R.L.S., dated March 29, 1960, entitled "Windsor Park", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book RR at page 25, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Woodridge Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 50 and 51, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 51 N. 71-0 W. 155 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Devonshire Road; thence with the Southeastern side of Devonshire Road N. 19-0 E. 110 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 49 and 50; thence with the line of Lot No. 49 S. 71-0 E. 155 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Woodridge Circle; thence with the Northwestern side of Woodridge Circle S. 19-0 W. 110 feet to the point of beginning.
