This Mortgage made this 22nd day of March, 19 60, between Samuel Earl Shuler and wife Mary Ann Shuler

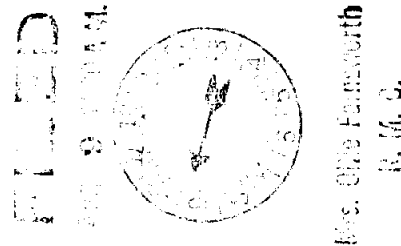
called the Mortgagor, and Wise Homes, Inc. of Spartanburg, hereinafter called the Mortgagee.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor in and by his certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith is well and truly indebted to the Mortgagee in the full and just sum of Thirty One Hundred Ninety Six & 80/100 Dollars (\$ 3196.80), with interest from the date of maturity of said note at the rate set forth therein, due and payable as follows: in equal monthly installments of \$ 44.40 commencing on the 25th day of June, 19 60, and a like amount on the 25th day of each successive month thereafter until the whole of said indebtedness is paid.

NOW THEREFORE, the Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of \$3.00 to him in hand paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents hereby bargains, sells, grants and releases unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in Greenville County, South Carolina:

All that piece parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the north side of South Tyger River and having the following courses and distances to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the north east corner of the Samuel E. Shuler property cornering with the Joel T. Roe property to the east and McElhaneey Road to the north, this being the point of beginning, thence; SW 400 feet along the center of old road parallel with the Birdwell property to an iron pin; thence SE 375 feet along other portion of the Samuel E. Shuler property to an iron pin, thence N. 3-15W. along the Joel T. Roe property 100 feet to the point of beginning, this being in Shape of a triangle. This being a portion of a 46.17 acre tract of land conveyed to Samuel E. Shuler by Nellie Ruth Shuler by deed dated Jan. 28, 1957, and recorded in deed book Q, page 598, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, State of S. C. Together with right to use old road for ingress and egress.



Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, or that hereafter may be erected or placed thereon.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

1. To pay all sums secured hereby when due.
2. To pay all taxes, levies and assessments which are or become liens upon the said real estate when due, and to exhibit promptly to the Mortgagee the official receipts therefor.
3. To provide and maintain fire insurance with extended coverage endorsement, and other insurance as Mortgagee may require, upon the buildings and improvements now situate or hereafter constructed in and upon said real property, in companies and amounts satisfactory to and with loss payable to the Mortgagee; and to deliver the policies for such required insurance to the Mortgagee.
4. In case of breach of covenants numbered 2 or 3 above, the Mortgagee may pay taxes, levies or assessments, contract for insurance and pay the premiums, and cause to be made all necessary repairs to the buildings and other improvements, and pay for the same. Any amount or amounts so paid out shall become a part of the debt secured hereby, shall become immediately due and payable and shall bear interest at the highest legal rate from the date paid.
