"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, situated on the east side of South Trade Street and the north side of Marchant Street in the City of Green, and being Lot No. 4 of the Marchant Place according to survey and blat by R.E. Dalton, Surveyor, dated November 5, 194, and recorded in Plat Book "C", page 196, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and verified by H.S.
