(235) The Coastal Plains 33 KV single-circuit transmission line extending from the Company's Wallace-Warsaw 33 KV Line, near Rosehill, North Carolina, to the Company's Coastal Plains 33 KV Substation, near Rosehill, North Carolina, a distance of .47 mile.

(495) The Cumberland Company 66 KV Substation located near the Town of Hope Mills, Cumberland County, North Carolina.

(496) The National Feed Company 66 KV Substation located near the City of Fayetteville, Cumberland County, North Carolina.

(497) The Rosehill Poultry Company 33 KV Substation located near the Town of Rosehill, Duplin County, North Carolina—under construction.
