

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Joseph Lee Sherman

in and by my certain Real estate

note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, am well and truly indebted to E.P. Edwards

in the full and just sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars

, to be paid Six months from date

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E.P. Edwards, his heirs and assigns forever:

That certain lot of land designated as no. 1-F in block no. 1 as shown on plat of the B.S. Sherman Estate, by H.S. Brockman, September 25th 1942, in Chick Springs Tewnship, in Greer School District #285, in the Western limits of the City of Greer, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at the western edge of a proposed 15-foot road at the southeastern corner of said lot, and runs thence with said road N 17-48 E seventy (70) feet to corner of lot No.1-G; thence as dividing Nos.1-F and 1-G lots, N 72-12 W sixty-eight and six-tenths (68.6) feet to iron pin on the Earle Duncan Estate line; thence with that line S 17-48W seventy (70) feet to iron pin; thence dividing 1-E and 1-F lots, S 72-12 E sixty-eight and six-tenths (68.6) feet to the beginning corner; and being the same conveyed to me by deed of Elsie Sherman, Trustee, June 9th, 1950, and recorded in the R M C office for this County in Deed Book 452 at page 102.
