Greenville Land Co., Inc., its successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 124 of a subdivision known as Orchard Acres, Section Two, as shown on a plat of a portion of said subdivision prepared by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, March, 1960, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at page 6, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern edge of Clingstone Drive, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 123 and 124, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 4-24 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 99; thence along the rear lines of Lots Nos. 99 and 98, S. 85-36 W. 108 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 53; thence along the rear lines of Lots Nos. 53 and 52, S. 10-14 E. 175.7 feet to an iron pin on the northern edge of Clingstone Drive; thence along the northern edge of Clingstone Drive, N. 85-36 E. 90 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Greenville Land Co., Inc. by deed of even date, to be recorded herewith.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, its successors ~~Heirs~~ and Assigns, from and against me, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
