WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, situated on the east side of State Highway No. 14 at Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, about one mile southward from the City of Greer, designated as Lot No. 1 in WOODLAND HEIGHTS, property of I.M. Wood Estate according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated October 28, 1955, recorded in Plat Book GG, page 151, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on northeastern corner of said highway and Bessie Avenue, and running thence along the north side of said Avenue, N. 45-18 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 64; thence along line of same, N. 39-15 W. 130.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40-50 W. 202 feet to an iron pin on the east side of State Highway No. 14; thence along said highway, S. 39-15 E. 114.7 feet to the beginning corner.
