"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greer and in Chick Springs Township, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 173 on a plat of property entitled Subdivision of Greer Mill Village, Greer, S.C., made by Dalton & Neves, January, 1951, revised July, 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at page 15. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 12 Connecticut Avenue and fronts thereon 68.5 feet. This is the same property as conveyed to the mortgagors by W. Dennis Smith by deed of even date and to be recorded herewith.
