(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Citizens Lumber Company
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 ---
DOLLARS (\$ 2,000.00),
with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6½ per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid:

In monthly installments of \$35.00 each on the 1st day of each month hereafter, beginning July 1st, 1960; payments to be first applied to interest, balance to principal, until paid in full; with interest thereon from date at the rate of six and one-half per cent, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly;

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Gantt Township, on the White Horse Road, and having, according to Plat made by W. J. Riddle in February 1949 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on White Horse Road, on line of property owned by Edd Roseman, and running thence along that line, S.45-30 W. 477 feet to iron pin on railroad right-of-way leading to Greenville Army Air Base; thence N. 52-07 W. 97.5 feet to iron pin on railroad right-of-way; thence N. 38-10 E. 472 feet to iron pin on White Horse Road; thence S. 52-50 E. 161.3 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same premises conveyed to Mortgagor by Deed recorded in Deed Book 376, at page 79, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
