NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 228 of Traxler Park as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book F, Pages 114, 115 and 116, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the northern side of Byrd Boulevard, 80 feet east of the northeastern intersection of Byrd Boulevard and Woodvale Avenue, which point is the joint southern corner of Lots 227 and 228, and running thence with Byrd Boulevard, S. 60-28 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint southern corner of Lots 228 and 229; thence with the dividing line of said lots, N. 29-32 E. 193.5 feet to an iron pin, joint northern corner of Lots 228 and 229; thence with the rear line of Lot 228, N. 57-40 W. 75.08 feet to an iron pin, joint northern corner of Lots 227 and 228; thence with the dividing line of said lots, S. 29-32 W. 197 feet to the point of beginning.
