to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, securing the payment of the principal sum of Seventeen Hundred -----(\$ 1,700.00) Dollars, dated the 28 day of September 19 53 , and recorded in the public records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina , in Mortgage Book 575 , at page 369 , the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Holliday Bridge Road, near Holliday's Dam and containing fifty-four and seventy-five one-hundredths (54.75) acres, more or less, according to survey and plat made by W. M. Nash, Reg. Land Surveyor, under date of May 27, 1943, with the plat being recorded in Plat Book N, page 87, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, South Carolina. It is the same land conveyed to Fred P. Chapman by John T. Chapman by deed dated May 16, 1945, recorded in Deed Book 275, page 369, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County. The said parcel of land is bounded by lands now or formerly of Maude Babb on the north; C. F. Chapman on the east; Casper Holliday and Rosa Smith on the south and by the said Rosa Smith on the west. It is the same parcel of land conveyed to Billy J. Chapman by Fred P. Chapman. Reference is here made to the Nash plat above referred to for a more detailed description as to courses and distances and metes and bounds. _____
