NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and furthersums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his accont by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township, containing 2.08 acres, more or less, described as follows on plat by Lewis C. Godsey, Surveyor, Januafy 31, 1960: BEGINNING in center of black-top county road which leads from McKittrick's Bridge to Fountain Inn, running thence South 18-14 West, corssing an iron pin 60.7 feet from said starting point, a total distance along line of lands of C. J. Jones 404.3 feet to iron pin on line of land of C. A. Tollison, thence with Tollison line South 71-15 West 318.8 feet to iron pin, thence North 4 East 244.7 feet to point in center of said County road, thence along center of said road North 66-38 East 280.4 feet to point in said road, thence North 48-28 East 199.8 feet to beginning; bounded by lands of C. J. Jones, Jr., C. A. Tollison and said county road.
