"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oneal Township, located on the west side of the old Rutherford Road and about three miles northwest from the City of Greer, being all of Lots Nos. 47, 48, 49, 50 and 51 on a plat of property made for I.D. Bishop by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated July 20, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a point in the intersection of the old Rutherford Road and a county road, and runs thence along the county road, N. 24-30 W. 441 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 52; thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 51 and 52, S. 88 E. 187.3 feet to a stake on the west side of the Rutherford Road; thence therewith S. 1-57 W. 400 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of that property conveyed to the mortgagor by Thomas W. and Alene F.
