June 30 , 1960, until one (1) month prior to the date the first rent becomes payable under the tem a millease dated July 20 , 1960, given by MORTGAGOR to MOREL Gas covering premises herein described, or until June 1, 1961, whichever date first occurs, interest only shall be paid and payment thereof shall be made to MCRTGAGEE within one (1) month after whichever of said dates occurs first; thereafter the said principal and interest at the aforesaid rate shall be paid in one hundred and twenty (120) consecutive monthly installments, each in the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX DOLLARS AND FIVE CENTS (\$166.05).
