We, Harry B. Jones, Jr., and Sybil M. Jones, SEND GREETING:

Whereas We . . . , the said Harry B. Jones, Jr., and Sybil M. Jones  
in and by our certain note in writing, of even date with these  
presents, are well and truly indebted to Mildred Orr Jones, hereinafter  
called the mortgagee, in the full and just sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Seven & 30/100  
Dollars , to be paid as follows: Forty Five & 00/100 (\$45.00)  
Dollars on September 15 . 1960, and a like amount on each and  
every succeeding month thereafter until paid in full; the final  
payment being due ten (10) years from date.

, with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

and Sybil M. Jones hand well and truly paid by the said Mildred Orr Jones

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Mildred Orr Jones, her heirs and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying  
and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler  
Township, on waters of Laurel Creek, adjoining lands of Brown, Hunt,  
Hipp, and Peace, containing 14.82 acres, more or less, and having,  
according to a plat prepared by S. A. Ellis, Surveyor, April 12, 1939,  
and a plat of adjoining property prepared by J. C. Hill, L. S., May  
10, 1948, the following notes and bounds, to wit:

N. 3 E. 55 feet to an iron sign in a small c. road, and running thence
