NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgager(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee.

THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF GREER, SOUTH CAROLINA, its successors and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being part of what is known as the old Washington Taylor Flace, and being located on the East side of the old Rutherford Road, near Fairveiw Baptist Church, and containing four (4) acres more or less, as shown by a plat of the property of Robert A. Ford, said plat being prepared by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, and dated September 19, 1936, and having the following mets and bounds, to-wit:
