NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, Allthat certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on both sides of Elisha Thompson's Beaver Dam Creek and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stone 3x on a small branch, and running thence with said branch as the line North 78 degrees East 2.28 chains; thence South 78 degrees East 3.25 chains; thence North 76½ degrees East 2.80 chains; thence North 84½ degrees East 2.27 chains to a stone 3x in branch; thence leaving the branch and running South 67 3/4 degrees East 30.50 chains crossing Beaver Dam Greek to stone 3x; thence North 24 1/4 degrees West 12.81 chains; thence North 23½ degrees West 20.05 chains to a stone 3x¢ thence North 77 degrees West 24.62 chains to a stone 3x; thence South 3 3/4 degrees West 25.65 chains to the beginning stone 3x on small branch, adjoining lands of 6.M.
