WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto AIKEN LOAN & SECURITY COMPANY

All that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of Starsdale Manor Subdivision made by Dalton & Neves, March 1956, recorded in plat book NN page 9 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. said lot having a frontage of 150 feet on the south side of Starsdale Circle, a depth of 148.1 feet on the east side and a depth of 115.8 feet on the west side, and a rear width of 153.5 feet.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
