at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Deluxe Homes, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, situated, containing I acre, more or less, in Greenville County, South Carolina, shown on a plat of the property of James H. Waldrop prepared by C. C. Jones, Engineer, on November 5, 1960, and having, according to this plat, the following mates and bounds: Beginning at an inon pin on the northeastern edge of Keeler Will Road, which point is 75 feet, more on less, southeasterly from the intersection of an old road, and running thence with the northeastern edge of Keclet Mill Road S 36-30 E. 210 feet to an iron pin, thence N 55-30 E 210 feet to an iron pine thence N 36-30 W 210 feet to an iron pin; thence \$ 55-30 W 210 fee to the point of beginning.

The above described tract is bounded on the Southwest by Keeler Mill Road, an on all remaining sides by the grantor, W. V. Waldrop.
