To all Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS I, William A. Leslie, of Greenville County  
well and truly indebted to I. L. Donkle, Jr. and John W. Hudson  
sum of Six Thousand and no/100 . . . . . (\$6,000.00) Dollars,  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date hereinafter due and payable as follows:  
On or before ninety (90) days from date,

with interest from date at the rate of 5-1/2% per centum per annum  
until paid; interest to be computed and paid at maturity; and if unpaid when due to  
bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further prohibited and agreed to pay ten per  
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal process,  
fees of any kind reference being thereto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN That I, the said William A. Leslie

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note and also  
in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the  
sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,  
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said I. L. Donkle, Jr.  
and John W. Hudson, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State  
of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying at the intersection of Winterberry  
Court and Cleveland Street and being shown as a portion of Lot No. 68 as shown on  
plat of property of Tully P. Babb being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book GG, at Pages 157-159. SAID LOT ALSO BEING KNOWN and  
designated as Lot No. 1 as shown on Plat No. 3, revision of Lots 59 through 68, of  
the property of the Estate of Tully P. Babb as shown on a plat thereof prepared by  
Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in May 1959 and having, according to said revised  
plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Cleveland Street where  
it intersects with the western side of Winterberry Court and running thence with  
Cleveland Street, N. 82-18 W. 107.6 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with  
Cleveland Street, N. 72-28 W. 93 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said  
Street, N. 62-21 W. 136 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said Street,  
N. 62-21 W. 7 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of a branch; thence with  
the center of said branch as the line, following the meanders thereof, the traverse  
line of which being N. 5-20 E. 48.2 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots  
Nos. 1 and 2; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 and leaving said branch,  
N. 83-10 E. 291 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Winterberry Court;  
thence with Winterberry Court, S. 6-50 E. 189.6 feet to an iron pin at the inter-  
section of Winterberry Court and Cleveland Street, the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same  
belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all heating, plumbing and electrical fixtures and  
any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the  
intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be con-  
sidered a part of the realty.

and John W. Hudson, their

Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagors, their Heirs  
and Assigns, from and against me, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
