NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagec at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Vance Street, in the Township of Greenville, City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 33 as shown on a plat prepared by J. N. Southern, Surveyor, entitled "Norwood Heights" recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County on October 9, 1906, in Plat Book A at page 133, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Vance Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 32 and 33, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 32 S. 74 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 32, 33, 56 and 57; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 57 S. 15% W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 33, 34, 57 and 58; thence with the line of Lot No. 34 N. 74 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Vance Street; thence with the Eastern side of Vance Street N. 15% E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagor herein and Ollie Guible by deed of J. A. Coggins, dated June 21, 1945, and recorded in the R. M. C.
