Payne, et al.; thence along the line of that property, N. 41-10 W. 213.8 feet to an iron pin at the corner of a lot conveyed to Don S. and Ruth Edens; thence along the Edens' line, S. 59-19 W. 262.8 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of said Paris Road; thence along the northeast side of said Paris Road, S. 41-10 E. 143.8 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to us by Joseph M. Bearden by deed dated February 7, 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 518, at page 184.
