TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Louie Price, and Inez G. Price,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Four Thousand ----- DOLLARS (\$ 4,000.00) with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six & one-half (6 1/2) per centum per annum, said principal and interest, to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Glassy Mountain Township, on State Highway No. 11 near Gowensville, containing 49.3 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances; BEGINNING on a stake, C.S. West and B.C. Adkins line in old road, and runs thence S. 82-3/4 E. 1.84 to a stake; thence N. 30 1/2 E. 26.38 to a stone on line of D.R. Evine Estate; thence N. 24-3/4 W. 22.37 to a stake on Green's Creek; thence up creek about 7 chains to the mouth of a small branch; thence up small branch about 11 chains to a stone; thence S. 83 1/2 W. 85 links to a stone on road; thence with road, S. 1 .5 E. 6.08 to turn in said road; thence S. 18 1/2 E. 6.30 to turn in said road; thence S. 10 1/2 E. 3.72 to turn in said road; thence S. 51 1/2 E. 2.77 to turn in said road; thence S. 10 1/2 E. 3.70 to turn in said road; thence S. 21 W. 1.30 to turn in said road; thence S. 27 1/2 E. 1 chain to turn in said road; thence S. 1 1/2 W. 2.24 to a stone on west side of road; thence up old road, S. 7.40 W. 4 chs. to the beginning corner.

ALSO, all that other certain parcel of land containing 6.97 acres, more or less, adjoining that above described, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: BEGINNING on an iron pin on the east side of a new road, T.P. Stewart corner near big White Oak; thence N. 30 1/2 E. 16.17 to a stone; thence S. 6-55 E. 18.54 to iron pin on south side of Glassy Mountain Road; thence S. 88 1/2 W. 1.56 to a persimmon tree; thence N. 6-55 W. 6.27 to iron pin in field, new corner between Ben T. Boone and T.P. Stewart; thence S. 78 1/2 W. 8.40 to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
