NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and hefore the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, being a nortion of an orderinal tract of \$2.25 acres, known as the Old Shockley Place.

being a portion of an original tract of 42,25 acres, known as the Old Shockley Place, located on Hunt's Bridge Road, about 8 miles from Greenville, and bounded by lands now or formerly of Gibson, Bob Williams and Sloan, and according to a plat prepared by W.
