NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, on the southeast side of Easley Bridge Road, being shown as Lot No. 11 on Map No. 2 of Camilla Park made by W.J.Riddle, December 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book M, at Pages 34 and 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Easley Bridge Road at joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11, and runs thence with the line of Lot 10, S. 60-51 E., 202.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-40 W., 80.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 12, N. 60-51 W., 205 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Easley Bridge Road; thence along Easley Bridge Road, N. 23-09 E., 80 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
