BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Miller Road at corner of other property of Boyce Miller and running thence along the Miller Road, S. 16-20 W. 81.7 feet to an iron pin on the southeast edge of said road; thence continuing along Miller Road, S. 29-35 W. 221.5 feet to an iron pin in line of other property of Boyce Miller; thence along line of other property of Boyce Miller, N. 41-17 W. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence still along line of other property of Boyce Miller, N. 31-15 E. 217.6 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the Miller line, S. 60-47 E. 211.4 feet to a point in the Miller Road, the beginning corner.
ALSO, LESS, the right of way condemned by the South Carolina State Highway Department for State Highway 85 containing approximately seven and one-half (7 1/2) acres.
