"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina County of Greenville, on the northeastern side of Fourth Avenue, near the City of Greenville being shown as Lot No. 138 on a plat of Section 1 of F. W. Poe Manufacturing Company, recorded in Plat Book Y at Fage 27, and described as follows: on the northeastern side
