SEND GREETING:

Whereas, we, the said Joseph Robinson and Catherine Robinson  
in and by our certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with those  
Presents, are well and truly indebted to Mrs. Jeanne D. Threatt

All that place, parcel of Lot of 1800 situated, lying, and being in  
Tennet Towne known and designated as Lot No. Thirteen (13) on plat of Chenie Drive,  
made by J. C. Miller, R. E. S., November 23rd, 1959, and recorded in the Register of  
Deeds Conveyances Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 09, page 377, and having  
according to said plat the following lines and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron post on Chenie Drive, to the Westerly side of Pleasant  
Grove Road, proceeding S. 10-11. 35-0 East, 54.1 feet along said Chenie Drive to an iron
